American Beech Fagus grandiflora





Beech Bark Disease: caused by a pathogen and the non-native beech scale insect eating away at the bark, and the tissues inside the tree. The combination of the 2 cause canker sores to appear on the bark of the tree leaving it bumpy and not smooth as it should be

Leaves:

 Rounded to a point
Parallel lines extended from center line
Bright green during summer
Orange / brown in fall

> Bark (typically): - Smooth - Silver / gray

Fruit: - Small - Hairy - Sharply angled nut
